

❖ The Visiting Team Report of the institution was considered by the Committee and the Committee noted that despite refusal of the application of the institution vide Order dated 20.01.2025 and remanding the case back by the Appellate Authority vide Order dated 16.09.2025, the institution is still deficient on the following grounds: -

- Land and building related documents viz. certified copy of Registered Land Documents issued by the Competent Revenue Authority, Building Plan, Building Completion Certificate, Non-encumbrance certificate and Certificate of Land use etc. issued by the Competent Government Authority were not shown to the VT members for verification.

- ❖ As per the decision of NRC taken in its 449<sup>th</sup> Meeting (Volume-II) held on 13-14 October 2025, SCN post LOI was issued to the institution on 29.10.2025. The institution has not replied / uploaded the documents in response to SCN post LOI within the stipulated time period on the portal.
- ❖ Accordingly, as per the decision of NRC taken in its 453<sup>rd</sup> Meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> December 2025, the application for B.Sc. B.Ed. *After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 22.12.2025 and remand the matter to the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) for fresh consideration and strict compliance with the directions specified hereinabove. The appellant institution is further directed to forward to the Regional Committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this order, the documents submitted along with the appeal, whereupon the Regional Committee shall take further necessary action strictly in accordance with law and in light of the direction contained herein.*

- ❖ In view of the above, the institution is required to forward to the NRC, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of appeal order, **documents submitted along with the appeal and point-wise reply on the grounds of refusal**, whereupon the NRC shall take further necessary action strictly in accordance with law and in light of the direction contained in the appeal order.

The appellant institution is further directed to forward to the Regional Committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this order, the documents submitted along with the appeal, whereupon the Regional Committee shall take further necessary action strictly in accordance with law and in light of the direction contained herein.</i></p> <p>❖ In view of the above, the institution is required to forward to the NRC, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of appeal order, the <b><u>documents submitted along with the appeal and point-wise reply on the grounds of refusal</u></b>, whereupon the NRC shall take further necessary action strictly in accordance with law and in light of the direction contained in the appeal order.</p> <p><b>Hence, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 15 days from the date of issue of this Show Cause Notice failing which the application of the institution seeking grant of recognition for the proposed programme shall be liable for refusal without providing any further opportunity to the institution.</b></p>


**Decision of NRC**
