The **491<sup>st</sup> Meeting** of the Southern Regional Committee (SRC), National Council for Teacher Education held on **18<sup>th</sup> March, 2026** through (**Blended Mode**) at the Conference Hall, SRC, NCTE, New Delhi.

At the outset **Sh. Mukesh Kumar, Regional Director**, and Convener, SRC welcomed the Chairperson and all other members, apprised about the work done by the SRC along with the directions received from NCTE Hqrs. from time to time.

**The Committee has taken up the following agenda items of 491<sup>st</sup> Meeting.**

College, Murandahalli Cross, Arahalli Post, Srinivasapura Road, Kolar, Karnataka-563101</p> <p><b>File No:- APS02423 Programme:- B.Ed.</b></p> <p>The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Initial recognition was granted for one year B.Ed. with annual intake of 100 seats on 25.11.2004.</li><li>2. After promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, a revised recognition order was issued on 16.05.2015 for two years B.Ed. Programme with annual intake of 100 students (2 units of 50 students each) with certain conditions.</li><li>3. Instead of compliance of the revised recognition order for two units, the institution vide letter dated 18.06.2015 and 06.07.2016 has requested to reduce the intake from 100 students to 50 students (1 unit).</li><li>4. The matter was considered by SRC in its 322<sup>nd</sup> meeting dated 20<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>th</sup> October, 2016 and the Committee decided as follows:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Request for reduction of intake from 2 Units to one Unit is accepted.</li><li>2. Ask them to submit all relevant documents for processing the case for issue of a new FR under the 2014 Regulations for B.Ed. (1 Unit).</li><li>3. If documents have already been received, process and put up.</li></ol></li></ol> <p>Accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution on 16.11.2016 for issuance of fresh recognition order of 50 students (1 Unit).</p>
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5. The institution has submitted its reply on 08.12.2016 which was considered by SRC in its 350<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2017 and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice dated 04.01.2018 was issued to the institution on certain grounds followed by a Final Show Cause Notice dated 02.02.2022.
6. Finally, the SRC considered the matter in its 408<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 02<sup>nd</sup> March 2022 and found that the institution is not fit for issuance of final recognition order even for 1 unit of B.Ed. Course. Accordingly, withdrawal order dated 15.03.2022 was issued to the institution from the academic session 2022-23.
7. Further, against the withdrawal order dated 15.03.2022, the institution preferred statutory appeal before the Appellate Authority. The Appellate authority vide its order dated 12.07.2022 remanded back the case to SRC for reconsideration as per law.
8. The SRC considered the documents submitted by the institution in its 413<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2022 and found that the institution is eligible for grant of 1 basic unit for B.Ed. Programme. Accordingly, Continuation/recognition Order dated 31.08.2022 was issued to the institution for B.Ed. programme with annual intake 50 students (1 basic unit).
9. The petitioner filed W.P.(C) No. 2902/2026 titled "Sri Hemadri Educational Trust Vs NCTE" before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi seeking the following prayer:

*"a. issue a writ of mandamus directing respondents to consider and decide the petitioner's application dated 03.06.2025 seeking increase of basic unit from 50 to 100 for the academic year 2025-2026, within a time bound period;*

*b. Direct respondents to conduct necessary inspection and pass a reasoned order on the petitioner's application."*

**The Hon'ble Court vide order dated 09.03.2026 disposed of the matter with the following directions:**

*"6. However, in view of the prayer in the present petition, I am inclined to allow the petition and the respondents are directed to consider the petitioner's application dated 03.06.2025 expeditiously and in any case not later than 6 weeks from today."*

**In light of the above, the Committee observed and decided as under:**

- In compliance of the Hon'ble High Court order dated 09.03.2026 passed in W.P.(C)2902 of 2026, the Committee considered the matter of the Institution seeking increase in intake capacity from 50 seats to 100 seats.
- Further, the Committee perused the decision taken by NCTE in its 55<sup>th</sup> General Body Meeting held on 14.07.2022, which is reproduced hereunder:

*"In light of the above, the Council members unanimously decided the following:-*

*1. At present, there are several institutions which have been recognised by the Regional Committees of NCTE wherein courses/ programme, other than diploma level courses, are running. An Expert Committee be constituted to devise the modalities for conversion of these recognised*

*institutions into multidisciplinary institutions in line with NEP 2020.*

*II. The applications pending before the Regional Committees of NCTE shall not be processed further. Hence, all such pending applications before RCs at any stage of processing be returned along with the processing fee to the concerned institution(s).*

*III. In the cases where the applications are being processed/ reopened as per the directions of the Hon'ble Court (s), the concerned Regional Committee shall file a review /appeal before the Hon'ble Court(s) along with stay application against the order passed by the Hon'ble Court(s) for processing of application(s) in view of the decision of the Council as taken in II above."*

- Therefore, after detailed examination of the proposal and the records and keeping in view the above decision taken by the Council in its 55<sup>th</sup> General Body Meeting held on 14.07.2022, the Committee observed that the application is devoid of merits.

**Keeping in view of the above, the SRC decided to reject the application. The institution may, however, submit a fresh application as and when applications are invited in future, in accordance with law.**

2. Consideration of Court order dated 29.01.2026 passed by Hon'ble High court of Karnataka at Dharwad in W.P. 106596/2017 C/W 108852/2016

The petitioner, Dakshina Bharata Hindi Prachara Sabha filed W.P. No. 106596 of 2017 C/W W.P.No. 108852 of 2016 challenging the Government Order dated 18.04.2017 whereby the State has withdrawn the recognition/equivalence earlier granted to *Hindi Shiksha Sanathak* qualification and sought to give effect to such withdrawal retrospectively affecting appointments and eligibility for the post of language assistant (Hindi) to give effect and challenging the notification dated 29.09.2016, by which, 2000 Amendment Rules were brought into force with retrospective effect from 23.03.2015, deleting *Hindi Shiksha Sanathak* as recognized qualification under the recruitment rules and mandating B.A as the sole professional qualification for appointment as language assistant.(Hindi), respectively.

The Hon'ble Court vide order dated 29.01.2026 passed in W.P. 108852/2016 held as under:-

**ORDER**

*"i. The writ petitions are allowed.*

*ii. It is declared that the Karnataka Education Department Services (Department of Public Instructions) (Recruitment) (Amendment) Rules, 2016 notified vide Gazette Notification dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure-J in WP.No.108552/2016), insofar as they gave retrospective effect from 23.03.2015 to the deletion of Hindi 2003 Rules Shiksha Sanathak as a recognized qualification for appointment to the post of language assistant (Hindi) are illegal, arbitrary and unenforceable.*

*iii. It is further declared that the said Amendment Rules, 2016 shall operate only prospectively from the date of their publication in the official gazette and*
