The **503rd (Emergent) Meeting** of the Southern Regional Committee (SRC), National Council for Teacher Education held on **16th June, 2026** through **(Online Mode)** at the Conference Hall, SRC, NCTE, New Delhi.

At the outset **Sh. Satish Kumar, Regional Director**, and Convener, SRC welcomed the Chairperson and all other members, apprised about the work done by the SRC along with the directions received from NCTE Hqrs. from time to time.

The Committee has taken up the following agenda item of 503rd Emergent Meeting.

1.	Amritha Akshita College of Education, Khasara No. 862, Plot No. 36-242, Metpally, Wanaparthi, Mahabubnagar 509103, Telangana File No.: - SRCAPP834, Programme: - D.El.Ed. The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: - The institution filed a contempt petition titled “Amritha Akshita College of Education Vs Ms. Sukhgeet Kaur (IOFS), Member Secretary, NCTE and Anr.” before Hon’ble High Court of Delhi seeking restoration order for the academic session 2026-27 instead of 2025-26. The matter is likely to be listed on 17.06.2026. Keeping in view the above, the SRC decided as follows: The contempt petition filed by the institution may be treated as a representation. Therefore, considering the said petition/representation and earlier orders passed in favour of similarly situated Institutions, a Revised Restoration Order be issued to the institution permitting to participate in the counselling for the Academic Session 2026-27 instead of 2025-26 for D.El.Ed. programme with annual intake of 50 students (One basic unit). The same shall be communicated to the university as well.

	The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: - The institution filed a writ petition bearing no. W.P. 7909 of 2026 before Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Amaravathi. The Hon'ble Court vide its order dated 05.05.2026 passed the following directions: <i>"15. Therefore, there shall be an interim order as under:</i> <i>(i) There shall be interim suspension of the impugned proceedings issued by Respondent No.3 vide File No. NCTE/2025/SRC/PAR/ORDER/APSO7040, Dated 01.06.2025, until further orders.</i> <i>(ii) The Respondent Authorities are directed to open the website/portal permitting the Petitioner/Institution to submit the Performance Appraisal Report ('PAR')."</i> The institution has also filed Statutory Appeal U/s 18 of NCTE Act, against the above mentioned withdrawal order dated 01.06.2025. The Appellate Committee passed its order dated 11.05.2026, the operative part of the order is reproduced hereunder: <i>"IV. DECISION:</i> <i>After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order, the material available on record, the submissions of the appellant institution, the binding decisions of the General Body dated 25.11.2025, and the legal opinion of the Legal Division, the Appeal Committee, in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, hereby sets aside the impugned order dated 01.06.2025 and remands the matter to the Southern Regional Committee for fresh consideration in accordance with law. The appellant institution shall immediately forward all documents submitted along with the appeal to the Regional Committee concerned. The Southern Regional Committee shall examine the matter afresh in terms of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE Regulations, 2014 (as amended), the binding decisions of the general Body, and applicable guidelines, and thereafter pass a reasoned and speaking order within a time-bound manner. The appeal stands disposed accordingly."</i> Keeping in view the above the Committee decided as under: A restoration order be issued to the institution for the B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students(2 basic units of 50 students each) and permit the institution to participate in the counselling for the academic session 2026-27. Further, RD SRC is directed to instruct IT Division, NCTE to open the website/portal permitting the institution to submit the Performance Appraisal Report (PAR).
