The **505th (Emergent) Meeting** of the Southern Regional Committee (SRC), National Council for Teacher Education held on **22nd June, 2026** through **(Online Mode)** at the Conference Hall, SRC, NCTE, New Delhi.

At the outset **Sh. Satish Kumar, Regional Director**, and Convener, SRC welcomed the Chairperson and all other members, apprised about the work done by the SRC along with the directions received from NCTE Hqrs. from time to time.

The Committee has taken up the following agenda item for 505th Emergent Meeting.

1.	Amritha Akshita College of Education, Khasara No. 862, Plot No. 36-242, Metpally, Wanaparthi, Mahabubnagar 509103, Telangana File No.: - SRCAPP834, Programme: - D.El.Ed.
	The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: - The institution filed a contempt case bearing no. CONT.CAS(C) 1056/2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The contempt petition was heard by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court passed order dated 17.06.2026. The operative part of the order is as under: <i>"5. In view of the above, the Respondents are directed to issue a revised restoration order in respect of the Petitioner, specifically permitting it to participate in the counselling process from the Academic session 2026-27 instead of 2025-26. The said shall also be communicated to the concerned university.</i> <i>6. Let the needful be done before 19.06.2026."</i> The O/o SRC received the order of the Court dated 17.06.2026 through the representation made by the petitioner institute via email dated 21.06.2026. Keeping in view the above, the SRC decided as follows: "In compliance of the directions passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 17.06.2026 in Cont. Cas(C)1056/2026, a revised Restoration Order be issued to the institution permitting the institution to participate in the counselling from the

	Academic Session 2026-27 for D.El.Ed. programme with annual intake of 50 students (One Basic Unit) . The same shall be communicated to the affiliating body/university as well."
2.	Jai Jyothi College of Physical Education, Chitta, Bidar, Bidar District – 585403, Karnataka File No. AOSO0296, Programme: C.P.Ed.
	The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: - • <i>The institution approached to the Hon'ble High of Delhi vide W.P. No. 6874/2026, and the Hon'ble Court vide its order dated 26.05.2026 directed the following:</i> <i>"5. Ms. Jhunjhunwala, learned counsel for the petitioner, states that the recognition for conducting D.P.Ed (erstwhile C.P.Ed) course was granted vide orders dated 21.08.2000, recognition was granted by the Southern Regional Committee. However, the respondents are not displaying the name of the College in the list of recognized institutions on their official website. Thus, the petitioners have approached this Court seeking to direct the respondents to update the status of the petitioner institute and display its name in the list of recognized institutions for the said course on their official website. He further points out that in the past, several orders have been passed by this Court issuing similar direction, copies of which have been filed along with the writ petition.</i> <i>6. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to verify the status of the petitioner institute and if upon verification the same is found to be a recognized institute, the respondents shall update the status on the website in the list of recognized institutions within 4 weeks. Thereafter, communication to this effect shall be sent to the affiliating body as well as Department of Higher Education, Government of Karnataka, within a period of two weeks from the date the status is uploaded."</i> • The institution was granted recognition for C.P.Ed., course of one year duration from the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 60. • There is no record available with us as to conversion of C.P.Ed into D.P.Ed course in respect of this institution. • C.P.Ed course was for one year duration whereas the D.P.Ed course is, at present, of two years. In view of the above, the Committee decides to seek the following inputs from the Regulation Division before asserting the recognition-status of the Institution w.r.t the D.P.Ed course: - Whether conversion of C.P.Ed course into D.P.Ed course has been allowed by the Regulation Division, NCTE? if yes, please provide the notification/circular/etc. - What is the status of the institution in respect of D.P.Ed course (recognised/non-recognised) at present, after omission of the norms meant for the C.P.Ed course of one year duration? - Whether this institution may be allowed to run D.P.Ed course of two

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	years at present ? if yes, what formalities are to be done ?
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The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the Chair.
