The **506th (Emergent) Meeting** of the Southern Regional Committee (SRC), National Council for Teacher Education held on **24th June, 2026** through (**Online Mode**) at the Conference Hall, NCTE, New Delhi.

At the outset **Sh. Satish Kumar, Regional Director**, and Convener, SRC welcomed the Chairperson and all other members and apprised them of the background of the emergent meeting.

The Committee has taken up the following agenda items under 506th Emergent Meeting. The item-wise decisions are as under:

1.	Nauman College of Elementary Teacher Education, Sy No. 374, Street No. 09, Kodad Village and Post, Nalgonda District-508206, Telangana. File No- SRCAPP1718, Programme: -D.El.Ed. The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were placed before the Committee and the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: - The institution filed a W.P. No. 8241/2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court passed order dated 17.06.2026. The operative part of the order is as under: "5. Accordingly, the present writ petition is allowed, holding that the directions passed by the Coordinate Bench in paragraphs Nos. 12 to 16 in the judgment of Teachers Training College Mirza (supra) shall apply to the petitioner, including the direction to permit the petitioner to participate in the counselling session for the academic session 2026-2027. 6. All respondents shall ensure that the petitioner is permitted to participate in the counselling for academic session 2026-2027." 3.	Bhongir College of Elementary Teacher Education, Sy. No 131,132, Anantharam Bhongir, Nalgonda District – 508116, Telangana. File No.: -APSO2804, SRCAPP1290, Programme: - D.El.Ed., D.El.Ed.-Addl. The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were placed

before the Committee and the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

1. The institution was recognized vide order No.F.SRC/NCTE/D.Ed./2005-2006/2575.

2. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn by SRC vide order No.F.SRO/NCTE/APSO2804/D.Ed./TS/2022 & F.SRO/NCTE/SRCAPP 1293/D.El.Ed. – A.I./TS/2022/137246,7250 dated 22.11.2022 on the grounds of non-submission of PAR for the Academic Session 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 and non-response to the Show Cause Notices.
3. The Appellate Authority NCTE vide its Order No. 89-137/E-364758/2025 Appeal/6th Meeting, 2025 APPLSRC202214501/E-87189/130730 dtd. 24.06.2025 confirmed the withdrawal order dated 22.11.2022.
4. The institution filed a writ petition bearing no. W.P.(C)12388 of 2025 titled "Bhongir College of Elementary teacher Education vs NCTE and anr". The Hon'ble Court vide its order dated 18.08.2025 directed as under:

"13. In the meanwhile, in view of the submissions made hereinabove, which prima facie appears to have substance and further regard being had to the fact that in somewhat similar matters relating to non-submission of PAR, the interim relief has already been granted by this Court in W.P.(C) 9718/2025, it is directed that the operation of the impugned withdrawal order passed by the respondent/SRC-NCTE, as well as, the appellate authority shall remain stayed till the next date and the petitioner is permitted to participate in the counselling and to admit the students in the academic session 2025-26. This may be done by the NCTE latest by 25.08.2025.

14. It is further directed that respondent/NCTE will issue a necessary public notice and upload the name of institute on its website thereby intimating all concerned, including State authority, affiliating authorities and counselling authorities that operation of the impugned withdrawal order/decisions in respect of the petitioner institute has been stayed by this Court and the institute has been permitted to participate in the counselling and admit the students for the academic session 2025-2026, which shall be complied with. This may be done by the NCTE latest by 25.08.2025."

5. Accordingly, a Public Notice dated 25.08.2025 was issued.

6. The institution further filed a CM Application no. 30801/2026 in W.P.(C)12388 of 2025 and the same was decided by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide its order dated 07.05.2026. The operative part of the order dated 07.05.2026 is reproduced as under:

"5. In this view, since the order of withdrawal of recognition has been stayed, there is no impediment in allowing the petitioner to participate in the counselling process of admission into D.Ed., D.El.Ed. -AI course for the academic session 2026-2027.

6. The respondents, in accordance with the paragraph No. 14 of the order, shall update its website by displaying the recognized status of the petitioner institution.

Keeping in view the above, the SRC decided as follows:

"In compliance of the directions passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 07.05.2026 passed in CM Application no. 30801/2026 in W.P.(C)12388 of 2025, a public notice be issued and the name of the institution be uploaded on NCTE website thereby intimating all concerned, including State authority, affiliating authorities and counselling authorities that operation of the withdrawal order dated 22.11.2022 and Appellate order dated 24.06.2025 in respect of the petitioner institute has been stayed by this Court and the institute has been permitted to participate in the counselling and admit the students for the academic session 2026-27.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the Chair.
