At the outset **Sh. Satish Kumar, Regional Director**, and Convener, SRC welcomed the Chairperson and all other members and apprised them of the background of the emergent meeting.

The following pertains to only one item out of the numerous items in view of the Court Case. The remaining items on the agenda under 510th Meeting are being posted separately. The decision is as under:

1.	BSR College of Education, Plot No. 82/5, Pamur Village & Post Office, Pamur Taluk & City, Prakasam District – 523108, Andhra Pradesh File No.: - SRCAPP2764, Programme: - D.El.Ed. The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were placed before the Committee and the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: - The recognition u/s 14/15 of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, BSR College of Education, Plot No. 82/5, Pamur Village & Post Office, Pamur Taluk & City, Prakasam District – 523108, Andhra Pradesh vide Order No F.SRO/SRCAPP2764/D.El.Ed./AP/2016/83605 dtd. 05.04.2016 for conducting D.El.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two Units) from the academic sessions 2016-2017. The institution filed a Writ Petition no. 6514 of 2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi seeking the following prayer: (a) <i>a Civil Writ of Mandamus under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for seeking direction to Respondent No.2 to decide, within a period of one week, the Representation of Petitioner Institution, made for seeking</i>
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	<i>updatation / inclusion of its name as an institution recognised for running the D.El.Ed. course; in the list of institutions being maintained on its website by the Respondent No.2; and</i> <i>(b) a Civil Writ of Mandamus under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for seeking consequent direction to Respondent No.2 to communicate the aforesaid updated / recognised status of the petitioner institution, to its Affiliating Body as also, the State Department of Higher Education; and/or</i> <i>(c) pass any such other orders/directions as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.</i> - The above said writ petition was disposed of by the Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 13.05.2026 with the following directions: <i>"2. For the reasons stated in the petition, issue notice.</i> <i>3. Mr. Rupal, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that the representation of the petitioner will be decided within 10 days from today.</i> <i>4. The decision on the representation of the petitioner Institute, subject to verification, shall be communicated to the affiliating body as well as the concerned department of the State Government and shall also be updated on the website immediately.</i> <i>5. The petition is allowed and disposed of in aforesaid terms."</i> - The Institution has filed a Contempt petition bearing case No. Cont.Cas(C) 1268/2026 with the following prayer: - <i>"It is therefore, in the interest of justice and in the facts and circumstances of the case, most humbly and respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:</i> <i>a. issue notice to the Contemnors calling upon them as to why the contempt proceedings shall not be initiated against them for having wilfully and deliberately disobeying the order dated 13.05.2026 passed by this Hon'ble Court in captioned W.P. (C) No.6514/2026; and</i> <i>b. issue notice to the Contemnors directing them to comply with the directions given in the order dated 13.05.2026 passed by this Hon'ble Court in W.P. (C) No.6514/2026; and</i> <i>c. punish the contemnors for having committed contempt of this Hon'ble Court;</i> <i>d. pass such other or further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the instant matter and in the interest of justice."</i> - The said contempt petition was listed before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court vide its order dated 23.07.2026 directed as under: <i>1. The present petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 13th May, 2026, passed by this Court in W.P.(C) 6514/2026.</i>
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	2. <i>Learned counsel for the respondents appears on advance notice, and on instructions, submits that the meeting of the Southern Regional Committee of the National Council for Teacher Education, is being convened today.</i> 3. <i>He further submits that the representation of the petitioner shall be considered today itself.</i> 4. <i>Accordingly, re-notify on 28th July, 2026.</i> Keeping in view, the above, the SRC decided as under: • In compliance of Hon'ble High Court Order dated 13.05.2026 passed in W.P.(C)6514 of 2026 and Order dated 23.07.2026 passed in Cont.Cas(C) 1268/2026, the office of SRC is directed to verify the present recognition status of the institution. Upon verification, if the institution is found recognised, the recognition status of the institution be uploaded on the website of SRC-NCTE in the list of recognized institutions. Further, the recognition status be communicated to the affiliating body as well as the concerned department of the State Government.

The institution is required to submit a proof that it has separate hostels for boys and girls for outstation students. 11. The institution is required to submit Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed proforma, duly approved by the competent authority along with duly notarized its English version, if the same is in regional language. 12. The institution is required to submit Fire Safety Certificate establishing that safeguard against fire hazard has been provided in all parts of the building. If the same is in regional language, duly notarised its english-version is required. 13. The institution is required to submit Building Safety Certificate indicating that the building of the institution has been constructed as per National Building Code and the same is fully safe and structurally sound having load bearing capacity as per the code/standards, to run the teacher training course. 14. The institution is required to submit a Barrier Free/Accessible Certificate establishing that the institution campus, building, furniture, etc. are barrier free/accessible. In view of the above, the Committee decided that the first Show Cause Notice be issued under section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of the Show Cause Notice on the above deficiencies.
53.	Roja College, Plot/Khasara No. 926, Plot No. 926, Main Road, Koilkunta Village and Post Office, Koilkunta Taluka And City, Kurnool District – 518134, Andhra Pradesh File No.: - SRCAPP52, Programme: -B.P.Ed. The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were placed before the Committee and the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: - • The institution was granted recognition vide order no. F. SRO/SRCAPP52/B.P.Ed/AP/2016/84771 dated 02.05.2016 for conducting B.P.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (One unit) from the academic session 2016-17. • The institution submitted an application dated 02.05.2025 for shifting of premises, along with documents and processing fee of Rs.1,77,000/-. • The SRC in its 461st meeting held on 26th – 27th May, 2025 considered the matter

and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice dated 02.06.2025 was issued to institution. The institution has not submitted reply to the Show Cause Notice.

- NCTE vide General Public Notices issued on 02.04.2024 and 09.09.2024 to all the TEI's to submit year-wise Performance Appraisal Report(s) (PARs) for the Academic Session(s) 2021-2022 & 2022-2023 on the NCTE portal through online mode during the period from 09.09.24 to 31.12.2024. Pursuant to which SRC decided to issue Show cause notices under the guidelines/directions issued. No reply was received from the Institute.
- The SRC issued withdrawal order on 05.06.2025 on the ground of non-submission of reply to the Show Cause Notice issued.
- Thereafter the Institution approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and filed a Writ Petition: 11342/2025 assailing the withdrawal order.
- The Hon'ble High Court vide an order dated 01.08.2025 directed:-

"It is further directed that respondent/NCTE will issue a necessary public notice and upload the list of institutes on its website thereby intimating all concerned, including State authority, affiliating authorities and counselling authorities that operation of the impugned withdrawal order/decisions in respect of such listed institutes have been stayed by this Court and they have been permitted to participate in the counselling and admit the students for the academic session 2025-2026, which shall be complied with. This may be done by the NCTE latest by 05.08.2025."

- In compliance of Hon'ble Court's Order, Public Notice was issued to the Institution. The matter is pending adjudication and next date of hearing is on 29.11.2025.
- The Institute approached the High Court of Delhi and filed a Writ Petition: 15855/25 seeking to quash the decision taken by the SRC, NCTE in its 468th meeting held on 28.07.2025 being beyond the scope of NCTE Act, 1993.
- The institutions has filed Writ Petition before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi bearing W.P C) No. 15855/2025, 15896/2025, 15924/2025 and 15926/2025 titled as Roja College, Sree Vyshnavi B.Ed. College, Jnana Bharathi College of Education & Deekshitha B.Ed. College, Versus NCTE & others whereby the Hon'ble High Court has directed that: -

"6. These writ petitions are filed on behalf of the Petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for quashing the decision taken by SRC, NCTE in its 468th Meeting held on 28.07.2025 as being beyond the scope of NCTE Act, 1993 and Regulations framed thereunder as also being violative of Articles 14 and 19(1)(G) of the Constitution of India. Direction is sought to SRC, NCTE to decide the applications of the Petitioners seeking permission for shifting the premisses of the respective colleges in terms of NCTE Regulations, 2014 in a time bound manner. As common question of law is raised in all the writ petitions, they are being decided by this common order."

7. *The primordial issue raised by the Petitioners in these writ petitions is whether applications seeking shifting of premises should mandatorily be accompanied with NOC of the concerned State Government. Mr. Rupal, learned counsel for the Respondents, on instructions, fairly and candidly submits that no NOC is required to be submitted by the colleges/institutions for seeking approval to shift the premises within the same State and that orders have been passed by this Court allowing similar writ petitions holding that NOC is not required.*

8. *In light of the stand taken by the Respondents and having perused the order dated 25.09.2025 passed in similar writ petition being W.P © No. 11974/2025, whereby the writ petition was allowed by the Court with a direction to process the application of the Petitioner, recoding the stand of NCTE that there was no requirement for furnishing NOC from the State Government in terms of NCTE Regulations, 2014, these writ petitions are allowed. Respondents are directed to consider the applications of the Petitioners after inspecting the concerned premises and to take a decision thereon within 10 days from today, considering that the counselling shall come to and end at the end of November, 2025.*

9. *No further orders are called for and the writ petitions are disposed of along with pending applications."*

1. A letter dated 28.10.2025 through email was sent to the Chairperson and members of the SRC, and NCTE Hqrs. seeking directions whether the requirement of NOC from the State Government for processing of the application for shifting of premises is mandatory or not. No inputs / reply till date has been received from either of the authorities i.e. Chairperson & Members of SRC and NCTE Hqrs. (copy enclosed)

2. On the decision of the SRC in its 475th meeting held on 16th – 17th October, 2025 a letter was issued to the Member Secretary, for seeking direction whether the requirement of NOC from the State Government for processing of the application for shifting of premises is mandatory or not. There after as per the direction given by the SRC in its 477th meeting held on 10th – 11th November, 2025 a Reminder letter was issued to the Chairperson, NCTE on 17.11.2025 on the same subject. No reply has been received till date from NCTE HQRs.

- The SRC in its 478th Meeting held on 24th – 25th November, 2025 considered the matter and decided as under:-

In view of the above, the Committee is of opinion and decides as below: -

- A Review Application may be filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi for the purpose of placing on record a copy of Letter No. APSCHE/CETs-B.Ed.-NoC of State/2025, dated 01.10.2025, issued by the Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education, and thereby to bring the said communication to the notice of the Court for its consideration.

It is also advised to RD-SRC to write a letter to Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education for obtaining the inputs and comments as per provision 7 (5) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 and amended Regulation, 2014 vide notification dated 05.05.2022.

- Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the Secretary, (SCERT) on 06.12.2025. No reply has been received till date.
- The SRC in its 480th Emergent Meeting held on 16th – 17th December, 2025 considered the matter and decided as under :-

Online Inspection for shifting of the premises of institution be conducted at **Roja College, 132/2, 132/3, Main Road, Bestavaripeta Village, Bestavaripeta Mandal, Prakasam District, Andhra Pradesh.**

- Against, the withdrawal order dated 05.06.2025 the institution has filed Writ Petition bearing No. 11342/2025 before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi titled as "**Roja College Versus NCTE & others**" whereby the Hon'ble High Court vide Order dated 20.03.2026 has passed following directions:-

"1. The learned counsels appearing on behalf of the petitioners urges the Court that the present petitions may also be disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court on 15.12.2025 in batch of petitions, lead case being W.P.(c) 5369/2025 titled as Teacher Training College Mirza vs. National Council of Teacher Education & Anr.

2. Mr. Anuj Kapoor and Ms. Geetanjali Mohan learned counsels appearing on behalf of respondents/NCTE submit that they have no objection in case such an order is passed.

3. In view of the above, the present petitions along with pending applications are disposed of in terms of order dated 15.12.2025, the benefit of which shall also ensure to the present petitioners."

- The SRC in its 496th Meeting held on 12th – 13th May, 2026 considered the matter and decided as under: -

*"The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide its order dated 20.03.2026 in W.P.(C) 11342/2025 titled **Roja College Vs National Council for Teacher Education** disposed of the writ petition with the following directions:*

"2. Mr. Sethi, learned Counsel for the respondents appears on advance notice, and states that the present matter is covered by the judgment of a Coordinate Bench of this Court passed in a batch of similar petitions, one of them being Teachers Training College Mirza vs. National Council for teacher Education and anr., W.P.(C)5369/2025, order dated 15.12.2025.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition is allowed, holding that the directions passed by Coordinate Bench in Paragraphs nos. 12 to 16 in the judgment of Teachers Training

College Mirza (Supra) shall apply to the petitioner, including the direction to permit the petitioner to participate in the counselling session for the academic session 2025-26."

Facts on Record: *As per the data available with SRC regarding submission/non-submission of PAR by the institutions, it is found that the petitioner has not submitted PAR for the academic session 2021-22 and 2022- 23. Hence, the institution does not fall within the purview of order dated 15.12.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi leading case being "Teachers Training College Mirza vs National Council for Teachers Education and ors".*

Keeping in view of the above observations, SRC decided that a Review Petition be filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi to review its above decision dated 20.03.2026 *on the ground that as per above facts on record petitioner institution cannot be said to be at par with the institutions concerned in earlier order dated 15.12.2025 in W.P.(C) 5369/2025 as the institution has not submitted PAR for the academic session 2021-22 and 2022- 23. Hence it is not entitled to the benefits of the said order. In the Review Petition Hon'ble High Court may be prayed to modify the order dated 20.03.2026 accordingly.*

The matter may be forwarded to the Member Secretary of NCTE for intimation and for further directions, if any, for filing Review Petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.

Further, the Committee unanimously decided that following advisory be issued to Mr. Anuj Kapoor, Standing Counsel, NCTE for Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, with respect to PAR matters:

Whereas, it has been observed that in certain matters before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, submissions are being made regarding "no objection" for passing orders in line with earlier PAR order dated 15.12.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi;

And whereas, it is considered necessary that the factual status relating to Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) and records maintained by the Southern Regional Committee (SRC) be duly verified prior to making any such submissions before the Hon'ble Court;

Now, therefore, it is hereby resolved and directed that Mr. Anuj Kapoor, Standing Counsel, NCTE for Hon'ble High Court of Delhi shall not make any submission, statement or give no-objection before the Hon'ble Court for passing orders in terms of the earlier PAR order dated 15.12.2025, unless and until the PAR status and related records are duly verified and confirmed by the Regional Director, SRC."

- The matter was again placed before SRC in its 499th meeting held on 26th May, 2026 and the Committee decided as under:

"The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

In compliance of the decision of SRC in its 497th Meeting held on 18.05.2026, Legal Consultant, SRC has prepared a detailed Report and put up before the Committee. The Report is taken on record. As per the said Report it has been provided that the present matter falls within the ambit of 68th General Body Meeting of NCTE and Order dated 15.12.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in PAR matters lead case being W.P.(C)5369 of 2025 titled "Teachers Training College Mirza vs National Council for Teacher Training" and that filing of review petition against Order dated 20.03.2025 of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi is not recommended.

Keeping in view of the above, the SRC decided as follows:

- *A restoration order be issued to the institution for the B.P.Ed. programme with an annual intake of 100 students (1 basic unit of 100 students) and the name of the institution be maintained on the website in the list of the recognised institutions. The State Government/Affiliating Body/University concerned also be informed accordingly. In the meanwhile, the petitioner institution is permitted to participate in the counselling for academic session 2025-2026 and admit students for the said academic session.*

Further, the SRC decided that a SCN be issued to the institution to submit the following documents within 21 days from the issue of this notice, to examine the instructional and infrastructural facilities available in the institution, as per NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines issued from time to time, failing which the process of withdrawing the recognition of B.P.Ed. programme of the institution will be initiated :

1. *Certified copy of Registered Land Documents, Change of Land Use Certificate, Latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate, Approved Building Completion Certificate and Building Plan, Mutation Certificate, Latest Fire Safety Certificate and Latest Building safety certificate issued by the concerned competent government authorities.*
 2. *Original copy of the FDRs in joint name of Institution and RD SRC.*
 3. *Latest faculty list duly approved by the concerned affiliating body.*
 4. *Website of the institution is required to be maintained/ updated as per provisions of NCTE Regulation (norms & Standards), 2014"*
- *Thereafter, the RD SRC sent the file to Inspection Division, NCTE with a request to conduct VT for shifting of premises for the institution (As per Note # 29 of E-File Comp. No. 23745).*
 - *However, certain clarification/documents, including copy of Restoration Order have been sought by the Inspection Division, NCTE and the inspection has not been conducted till date.*
 - *In the meantime, the institution filed another writ petition W.P.(C) No.*

9950/2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The limited prayer of the petitioner institution was to decide the application dated 29.04.2025 for shifting of premises. The matter was listed before the Hon'ble High Court on 22.07.2026 and as per the email dated 22.07.2026 of the Standing/Panel Counsel, NCTE, the Hon'ble Court directed SRC to conduct VT and to decide the application for shifting of premises in a time bound manner. The email of the Counsel is reproduced hereunder:

"Dear Sir,

The captioned matter was listed today for hearing.

The limited prayer of the Petitioner-college was to decide the application of the college for shifting of premises dated 29.04.2025.

In view of the limited prayer sought, the Hon'ble Court has directed the SRC to conduct the inspection within two weeks from today and to decide the application of the college for shifting of premises within two weeks thereafter.

The matter stands disposed of with the above directions.

This is for your kind information and necessary action."

- Order dated 22.07.2026 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C)9950/2026 has been uploaded on the website belately.
- The operative part of the Order dated 22.07.2026 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C)9950/2026 is as under:

3. *"Mr. Rupal, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.*
4. *Since the prayer in both the petitions is only to direct the respondents to decide the applications of the petitioner institutes for shifting of premises in a time bound manner, the respondents shall conduct an inspection within 2 weeks from today and decide the applications within 2 weeks thereafter.*
5. *The petitions are disposed of in the aforesaid terms."*

Keeping in view, the above, the Committee decided as under:

The Regional Director, SRC is directed to issue restoration order in favour of the institution, if not already issued, in compliance of the decision taken by SRC in its 499th meeting held on 26th May, 2026.

Further, a copy of the Court Order dated 22.07.2026 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C)9950/2026 be forwarded by the Regional Director, SRC to the Inspection Division, Headquarters, for information and necessary action, with the intimation that the Hon'ble High Court has directed that the inspection of the institution be conducted within a period of two weeks from 22.07.2026.

The Inspection Division may take necessary action in the matter in view of the time-

Accordingly, a withdrawal order dated 24.04.2019 was issued to the institution. - The institution filed a Writ Petition no. 16104 of 2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Amaravathi thereby assailing the withdrawal order dated 24.04.2019. - The writ petition came to be disposed of by the Hon'ble High Court vide its common order dated 14.07.2026. The operative part of the Court order reads as under: <i>4. Having regard to the submissions made, the Writ Petitions are allowed in terms of the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.26846 of 2024 & batch, dated 27.10.2025, and the impugned proceedings are set aside. However, the respondent authorities are at liberty to issue notices to the petitioner institutions, if any deficiencies are found, and to pass appropriate orders thereon after affording the petitioners due opportunity of hearing. There shall be no order as to costs.</i> - In this regard a representation of the institution, addressed to the Regional Director, SRC has been received by email Keeping in view, the above, the SRC decided as under: The Regional Director, SRC is directed that a Review Petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Amaravathi may be filed against the Common Order dated 14.07.2026 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh in WP 382 of 2026 and batch.

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were placed before the Committee and the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: - - The institution was granted recognition vide order no. F.SRO/SRCAPP3417/B.Ed./AP/2016/84572 dated 25.04.2016 for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 students(1 unit) from the academic session 2016-17. - The SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th – 15th September 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 22.02.2021. The institution has submitted its reply on 12.03.2021. - The SRC in its 405th Meeting of SRC held on 13th – 14th December, 2021

considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 27.12.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 27.12.2021.

- The SRC in its 409th Meeting of SRC held on 29th -30th March, 2022 considered the matter and decided as under:

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 27.12.2021. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

- 1. The institution was informed that the size of the class rooms and Hall are not readable in the building plan. The institute did not submit the same.*
- 2. The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(1), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*
- 3. The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty & non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*

Hence, the recognition granted to Rana B.Ed. College, Plot No. 110 1A, Kondampalli Village & Post office, Penukonda Taluk, Anantapur City, Anantapur District-515110, Andhra Pradesh for B.Ed. Course is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the next academic session i.e. 2022-2023. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stand withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate in counselling/making admissions from the next academic session i.e. 2022-2023.

Accordingly, a withdrawal order dated 20.04.2022 was issued to the institution thereby withdrawing the recognition granted to the institution for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (One Basic Unit).

- Against the said withdrawal order, the institution filed a writ petition no. WP 12676 of 2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Amaravathi.
- The said writ petition came to be disposed of by the Hon'ble High Court vide its common order dated 14.07.2026. The operative part of the Court order reads as under:

4. Having regard to the submissions made, the Writ Petitions are allowed in terms of
