Subject: Direction to Legal Counsels of SRC to Provide Timely updates Regarding Court Orders/Directions-reg.

WHEREAS there are several pending court cases against the Southern Regional Committee/NCTE before various High Courts, and it is imperative for the Committee/Council to stay updated on the developments and progress of the cases, including any decisions, directions or orders passed by the court.

AND WHEREAS, the Council's appointed Standing/Panel Counsels have been entrusted with representing the Council in these matters before their respective High Courts. However, it has come to the attention of SRC/NCTE that timely and regular updates regarding the court orders, decisions and directions have not been provided, resulting in a lack of transparency and delays in the SRC/NCTE ability to take necessary actions based on the outcomes of such cases.

AND WHEREAS, the effective and timely communication of court orders etc. and updates is critical for ensuring that the SRC/NCTE can respond promptly to any legal developments and take appropriate action to safeguard its interests.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Southern Regional Committee hereby directs the Standing/Panel Counsels of SRC representing the SRC/NCTE in the ongoing cases before their respective High Courts to:

- (a) Provide timely and regular updates to SRC/NCTE, specifically within 2-3 days of receiving any court orders, decisions or directions.
- (b) Ensure that a written summary or a formal report of each court order etc., along with any necessary next steps or actions required by SRC/NCTE, is submitted to the NCTE at the earliest through E-mail.

In case of any delay or inability to provide the updates within the stipulated time frame, the Standing/Panel Counsel is required to immediately notify SRC/NCTE with reasons for the delay.

AND WHEREAS, by unanimous decision of the Southern Regional Committee, it has been proposed that an online meeting in this regard be conducted with the Standing/Panel Counsels of SRC.

RESOLVED FURTHER that a copy of this resolution be sent to the appointed Standing/Panel Counsels for their acknowledgment and compliance.
