

As reflected in our earlier correspondence, IGNOU had informed NCTE that the University would not offer ITEP in face-to-face mode for the academic session 2024-2025, and accordingly requested removal of IGNOU's name from the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) 2024 admission cycle. This was intended as a temporary measure arising out of administrative considerations, while ensuring that the University continued to support and facilitate the academic progression of the already admitted 2023-2027 batch of ITEP students.

After a comprehensive internal review and given the successful running of ITEP over the past two years and the effective piloting of the curriculum, the University has now resolved to continue offering the ITEP Programme. Accordingly, the earlier communication requesting withdrawal of IGNOU's name from

NCET 2024 may kindly be treated as revoked.

It is further reiterated that IGNOU remains fully committed to strengthening teacher education in alignment with the objectives of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and looks forward to the continued support and guidance of NCTE."
