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The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- The recognition was granted to the institution namely **Chaudhary Charan Singh Mahavidyalaya, Kaptan Ganj, Padmapur, Pandav Nagar, Basti, Uttar Pradesh** for offering **B.Ed. course** of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide order No. F. No. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-1693/6984-6993 dated 27.07.2005 followed by revised recognition order for B.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 seats (two units of 50 students each) vide Order dated 28.05.2016.
 - As per the decision of NRC taken in its 433rd meeting (Vol-III) held on 30th & 31st January 2025, the committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to the institution for offering B.Ed. course under section 17 of the NCTE Act 1993 on the pretext that the institution had not submitted the reply of First SCN dated 11.05.2024. Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution on 29.03.2025.
 - The institution filed an appeal under section 18 of NCTE Act 1993, against the withdrawal order dated 29.03.2025. The appellate authority passed an Order No. 89-307/E-376246/2025 Appeal/10th Meeting, 2025 APPLNRC202515077/32338 dated 01.09.2025 remanding the case back to NRC with following directions: -
*After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to set-aside the impugned order dated 29.03.2025 and remand back the case to NRC **with a direction to verify the documents submitted in appeal from the concerned affiliating University.** The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the NRC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the Appeal and after receipt of the same the NRC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above.*
- ❖ In compliance of appeal order, the institution has submitted a letter dated 01.09.2025 received in NRC office on E-receipt No. 383524 dated 18.09.2025. The Committee considered the reply and found the same deficient on the following grounds: -

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<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The institution has submitted photocopy of FDR's of Rs. 5.00 Lakh & Rs. 7.00 Lakh matured on 18.06.2021. The institution has not submitted the renewed original FDRs. The institution has submitted building plan signed by the Gram Pradhan. The same is not approved by Competent Government Authority and the built-up area for offering B.Ed. course is also not earmarked thereon. The institution has submitted the land use certificate dated 24.09.2014 issued by the SDM, Basti, Uttar Pradesh, however, the recognition was granted to the institution on 27.07.2005. Hence, it is evident that at a time of initial recognition to the institution, the use of land was not converted for educational purpose. The institution has submitted the building safety certificate dated 23.05.2025 issued by the Adhishasi Abhiyanta, PWD in favour of the Vidyalaya building and not in the name of the Chaudhary Charan Singh Mahavidayaya. The institution has submitted the fire safety certificate dated 19.05.2025 issued by the Mukhya Agnisaman Adhikari in favour of the Vidyalaya building and not in the name of the Chaudhary Charan Singh Mahavidayaya. The institution has submitted (BCC) Building Completion Certificate issued by the Gram Pradhan instead of Competent Government Authority. The institution has not submitted the latest list of faculty in prescribed format duly approved by the affiliating University. The institution has not submitted details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with Six-months bank statement and account number of each faculty members. <p>Hence, the Committee decided that that withdrawal order dated 29.03.2025 withdrawing recognition of the institution for offering B.Ed. course under section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 stands.</p>

 - As per the decision of NRC taken in its 312th (Emergent) meeting held on 14th February 2020, a letter dated 22.06.2021 was issued to the institution by NCTE (HQ) on the VT Report received under Section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993 and also, as per the decision of NRC taken in its 361st meeting held on 13th -14th January 2022, a letter dated 02.02.2022 was issued to the institution to furnish its comments on the complaint received against the institution.
 - The institution submitted its reply to NCTE (HQ) vide letter dated 05.07.2021 and with regard to furnish the comments on complaint, the institution vide letter dated 02.03.2022 requested for extension of time to submit reply.
- ❖ The Committee considered the matter and noted that the institution is deficient on the following grounds: -
- The institution has not submitted the reply of NRC letter dated 02.02.2022 and as such, it has not furnished the comments on the complaint till date.
 - Certified copy of the registered land deed issued by the Revenue Authority is not submitted.
 - Latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority is not submitted.
 - Change of land use (CLU) certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority is not submitted.
 - Mutation certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority is not submitted.
 - An affidavit on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper in the prescribed format of NCTE regarding land and built-up area is not submitted.
 - The institution has not submitted the Blueprint of approved Building Plan duly signed by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the

The website of the institution is not updated as required under sub-regulation 8(6), 8(14) and 10 (3) of NCTE Regulations 2014. Latest copies of the affiliation orders for the last three years issued by the affiliating body for each course being run by the institution/ society, is not submitted. <p>Hence, the Committee decided that that recognition granted to the institution for offering B.Ed. & B.Ed. Add. course be withdrawn under section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order.</p>

The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- The recognition was granted to the institution namely **M G Educational and Training College, Plot Number- Arazi No. 842, 843/1, 843/3, Street/Road-0, Village/Town/City- Sindhora, Post office-Sindhora, Tehsil/Taluka-Sadar, Town/City- Mirzapur, District- Mirzapur, (UP), State-Uttar Pradesh** for offering D.El.Ed. course of two year duration for with annual intake of 50 students from the academic session **2015-2016** vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-7564/231st /232nd Meeting/89376-390 dated **03.03.2015**.
- The recognition was also granted to the aforesaid institution for offering B.Ed. course of two year duration for with annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2022-2023 vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13052/338th (Virtual)meeting (Part-2)/2021/215053-58 dated 06.08.2021.
- ❖ The Committee was apprised that the petitioner institution had earlier submitted that its D.El.Ed. programme was duly accorded recognition by the Northern Regional Committee (NRC), National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), by following verification of all requisite statutory compliances and documentation. Notwithstanding such recognition, it was noted that the institution's name has not been reflected in the list of "Recognized Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs)" published on the official website of the NCTE.
- ❖ It was further brought to notice that as recorded in the 255th Meeting of the NRC, recognition for an additional intake of two units in the D.El.Ed. course had been granted to the institution with effect from the Academic Session 2017-2018. The institution has stated that it never received any formal recognition order in this regard. The non-receipt of the order remained unnoticed by the institution since it had been permitted to admit students continuously from the Academic Session 2017-2018 onwards without any objection or interruption from the authorities concerned.
- ❖ The Committee was further informed that the petitioner institution has approached to the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi by filing W.P. (C) No. 16942/2025.

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<p>The Hon'ble Court vide its Order dated 12.11.2025 disposed of the petition and directed the NRC-NCTE to issue a formal recognition order to the Petitioner Institution within a period of three weeks from the date of the order.</p> <p>In view of the above, the Committee took note of the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court and decided for issuance of the formal recognition order to the institution for offering D.El.Ed. - The recognition was granted to the institution namely **Shanti Amar Singh College of Education, Plot No. 104, Village-Babupur, Katra Post office-Subhan Sangipur, Tehsil/Taluka-Lalganj, Distt. Pratapgarh, Uttar Pradesh-230139** for B.Ed. course of one year duration with annual intake of 50 students (2 units) from the academic session 2015-2016 vide order No. F. No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-4348/249th (Part-1) meeting/139399-04 dated 16.02.2016.
- The institution filed W.P. (C) 13892/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The Hon'ble Court of Delhi passed an order dated 19.09.2025 with the following directions: -
 3. *The present petition has been filed seeking direction to respondent no. 2/NRC to rectify/update its website by uploading recognition order dated 16.02.2016 whereby petitioner has been granted recognition for 02 units of B.Ed. Course with intake of 50 students each.*
 4. *Mr. Rishabh Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submits that inadvertently the website is showing one unit of B.Ed. instead of approved 02 units.*
 5. *In view of the above, issue notice.*
 6. *Mr. Mohinder J.S. Rupal, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents/NCTE accepts notice.*
 7. *On instructions, he submits that necessary rectification will be carried out in the website of respondent no.2/NRC latest by 22.09.2025.*
 8. *Let needful be done, as undertaken.*

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9. Consequently, the respondents/ NCTE are also directed to inform affiliating university about the said rectification.

10. In view of the above statement of Mr. Rupal, Mr. Kumar submits that no further orders are called for.

11. The petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

- Pursuant to the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi Order dated September 19, 2025, in W.P. (C) 13892/2025, Column No. 6 of the table mentioned in para 3 of the Recognition Order bearing No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-4348/249th (Part-1) meeting/139399-04 dated 16.02.2016 granting recognition to the institution namely **Shanti Amar Singh College of Education, Plot No. 104, Village-Babupur Katra, Post office- Subhan Sangipur, Teshil/Taluka-Lalganj, District-Pratapgarh, Uttar Pradesh-230139** for offering B.Ed. of two-year duration, the approved annual intake mentioned therein was required to be read as **100 students (2 units)** in place of 50 students (1 unit).
- Accordingly, Corrigendum Order was issued the institution on 22.09.2025.

In view of the above, the Committee ratified the action taken by the office of NRC in compliance of the Court Order dated 19.09.2025.

The Committee further observed that the institution is deficient on the following grounds: -

- At a time of initial recognition, the institution had submitted the list of faculty approved by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Awadh University, Faizabad dated 06.11.2015 containing approval of one HOD and 13 Assistant Professors. The number of faculty appointed by the institution is sufficient for only one unit of B.Ed. course, as per NCTE Regulations 2014.
- The VTR of the institution reveals that the institution has total land area of 2950 Sqm. and total built-up area measuring 1523 Sqm which is sufficient for offering one unit only of B.Ed. course.
- As per the affidavit on Rs. 100/- non-judicial stamp paper submitted by the institution regarding land and built-up area, the institution itself admitted that it has total land area of 2950 Sqm. and total built-up area measuring 1523 Sqm.

Hence, the Committee decided that First Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 15 days from the date of issue of First Show Cause Notice.

- The recognition was granted to the institution namely **Sri Narayan Girls PG, College, 560/2, Civil lines, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh** for offering B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 80 students from the academic session 1998-1999 vide order No. F3/UP-272/99/16596-6601 dated **24.02.1999**.
- After promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution had not consented to adhere with the NCTE Regulations 2014 and affidavit in this regard was not submitted by the institution. Hence, revised recognition order for B.Ed. two-year duration could not be issued to the institution.

The institution has submitted a reply to Final SCN on 17.04.2025. The Committee considered the reply and found the same deficient on the following grounds: -

- The institution has submitted an Agreement of land which is between Sanjeev Gupta and Baba Shri Chand Memorial Trust, however, the same is not registered in the office of Sub-registrar concerned.
- Further, the Agreement of land is not acceptable as per NCTE Regulation 2014. The said Regulations provide that the land free from all encumbrances could be either on ownership basis or on lease from Government or Government institutions for a period of not less than thirty years.
- Building plan submitted by the institution is signed by an Architect and approved by Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Paonta, Urban Development Authority. The seal of the approving authority is not stamping on the building plan.
- Building plan is for plot no./Khasra Nos. 3131, 3132, 3133, 3134, 3135, 3136, 3137, 3138, 3139 & 3140 of total land area 6643.09 sq.mtr, whereas the land agreement submitted by the institution is for Khasra No. 126/1 of land area of 8 bigha which do not tally with each other.
- Multipurpose hall is not depicted on the building plan.
- The building completion certificate submitted by the institution is not in the prescribed format of the NCTE. Total area of land is not mentioned in the BCC. The plot no./Khasra no./House no.166/167 mentioned in the BCC do not tally with the agreement of land and building plan.
- Land use certificate for plot No./ Khasra Nos. 3131, 3132, 3133, 3134, 3135, 3136, 3137, 3138, 3139 & 3140 submitted by the institution is issued by the Tehsildar whereas the land agreement is for plot no./Khasra Nos. 126/1.
- NEC submitted by the institution is issued by the Tehsildar for the plot Nos./Khasra Nos. 3131, 3132, 3133, 3134, 3135, 3136, 3137, 3138, 3139 & 3140 whereas the land agreement is for plot No./Khasra No. 126/1.
- The list of faculty submitted for D.El.Ed. programme is not in the prescribed format of NCTE.

- The site plan showing that the Plot Nos./Khasra Nos. are contiguous in nature with demarcated land area for offering miscellaneous courses, duly approved by the Competent Government Authority is not submitted.
- The institution has not uploaded the Building Safety Certificate citing that the building of the institution has been constructed as per National Building Code and the same is fully safe and structurally sound having load bearing capacity as per the Code/ Standards, for offering the teacher training course, issued by Competent Government Authority.
- The institution has not submitted the Fire Safety Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
