3. The online inspection was conducted on 22.08.2023. and VT report received on 22.08.2023. The SRC in its 428<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 considered the matter and decided as under:-

*(i) The Visiting Team report was received on 22.08.2023. The Committee observed that from the VT Report no document or any other information sought by the V.T. Team could be provided by the institution.*

***Therefore, the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 7 days from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.***

4. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 05.09.2023.
5. The institution has submitted its written representation vide dated 19.09.2023 and received on 26.09.2023.

  - The institute was unable to present the original copy of the land register and deed at the time of online inspection.
  - The institute was granted recognition for B.Ed. course in 2007 and even today at the time of inspection the institute does not have approval of faculty members for B.Ed. course from the affiliated university.
  - The institute has not made any provision for fire safety.
  - The multipurpose hall of the institute is smaller than the standard prescribed by NCTE, and no resource rooms of any kind were available in it.
